Cards #301-330 are super short-printed (SSP) and there are (40) cards in the set that have image variations. Parallel cards include Aurora #/25 and Alloy #/149. Printer plates (1/1) are included for each card (4 colors per card).

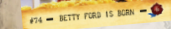
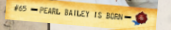
